The Basic Text History is a must see and is the most rewarding thing I think you could do for yourself, sponsees and friends!!!!

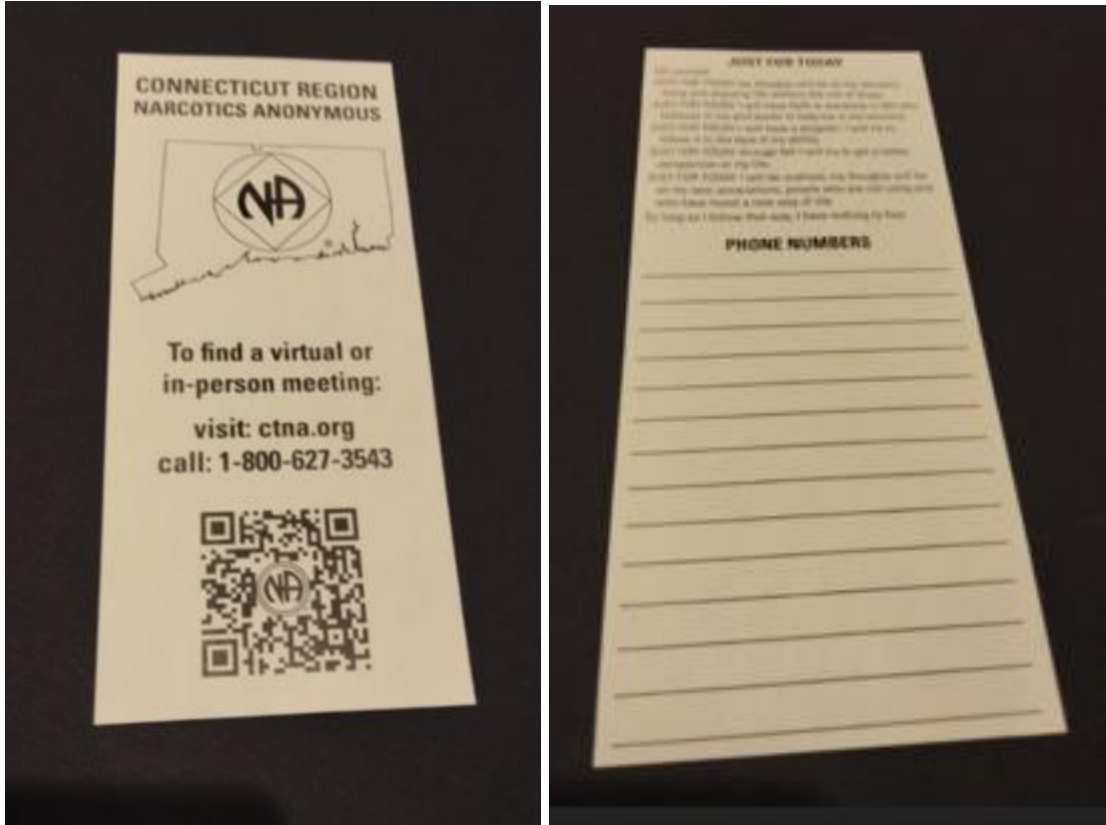
It was just way awesome.
