

There is a charge of \$41.00 on the report and bank statement that is the refund of Our Common Bond's donation, received via PayPal. PayPal will no longer allow us to access the funds in our PayPal account because we need to provide a Tax ID number and shipping/delivery receipts, as well as provide more information about our "business." As we are not an actual business, we have no shipping or delivery receipts to show, and will have to close the business PayPal account and open a Personal PayPal account under HASCONA if we want to continue using PayPal.

I do not know why the \$41.00 is being pulled from our bank account, as the donation was never deposited into our account, but the transaction has until 6/7/2022 to process, and my thinking is that there will be a credit deposit to "zero out" the debit posted within the next few days. If there's not, I will call PayPal and go from there.

Discussion ensued about getting a Tax ID number as a 501(c)(3) non-profit corporation. One advantage is that HACNA could use our Tax ID number to get two tax-free days per year, and we could possibly schedule HACNA during those days and everything sold during the convention from noon Friday to noon Sunday would be tax-free.
