On our yearly Budget for 2023, I had previously listed the “January Available Balance” at \$21,913.58 because that’s what it was on 1/1/2023. **This is incorrect.** Upon doing a deeper dive into the budgets of previous years, the “January Available Balance” is the available balance as it is on 1/31/2023. **The correct number is \$18,652.72**, and that change reduces our budget significantly. Adjustments/amendments will need to be made to Alive & Kicking’s financial proposal during Old Business in order to not go over budget by \$1,585.28. Please see the attached graphic of what our budget looks like today (Column D) and what it **will** look like if the A&K Proposal passes **without** any amendments (Column C). I apologize for the confusion this has created, and I appreciate your patience and understanding as I have been learning as I go.

VII. OPEN DISCUSSION

 - 4. **Instead of Poster Days do Banner Days** where all the Groups meet at a central location along with their banners (or create them on site if they don't already have one), and every Group gives their banner to another Group. This gets the ball rolling.

The meeting was adjourned at 12:41 pm with a moment of silence followed by the Third Step Prayer.
