b. PROPOSAL – Area Activities budget to reimburse HACNA \$250.00 for the 7/6/2024 fundraiser. **PASSED.**

1. **DISCUSSION:** the total cost of the rental was \$300.00, so one group supports this proposal. Doesn't HACNA have their own budget to put on events, or do the Groups/Area fund HACNA fundraisers? HACNA has their own seed money at the beginning of each convention term, and they give all the proceeds from the convention (minus the *next* convention's seed money) to HASCONA. Without a HASCONA Activities Chair, HACNA's intention was that they could put on an Area event co-sponsored by HACNA, with help from the HASCONA Activities budget. Will HACNA be requesting more money for future events? Julian says he doesn't think so, but he can't definitively answer that question without input from the HACNA subcommittee. Two more groups support the proposal to reimburse HACNA, but they thought the amount was \$250.00 rather than \$300.00, because that's what was in the minutes. We believe it was not reflected correctly in the minutes – Julian states it would only be fair to keep it at \$250.00 for that reason. Another group does not support the proposal because 1) they would hope the proposal came to us before the money was spent, rather than after, and 2) subcommittees should use their own funds as are available to fund their own events.

CONSENSUS AGREES TO REIMBURSE HACNA \$250.00, and Treasurer will contact Julian to pay them.

VII. NEW BUSINESS

- a. **Juntos Podemos mentioned needing funds to send Fernando M.'s remains back to Mexico. Can the area donate?** Contact Rolando to see about setting up some arrangements to hold a fundraiser, etc. That would be the proper way to donate, rather than funds coming directly from this body. Per Rolando, if anyone wants to contribute that is fine and thank you, but let's keep this all informal. Just contact Rolando with your personal intention to donate for ways you can contribute.
- b. **We need ways to spend all that "extra" money in our bank account.** Literature would be a good way to contribute to Area H&I. Or the ASC could buy literature and donate the books to all Area Groups for any members attending groups that cannot afford to purchase their own literature. There are 35 different groups in this Area. Point of Information: *Our Primary Purpose* group's policy is to give away literature to newcomers. Dave with *Rainbow of Hope* will write up a proposal to present at next month's ASC.

- c. **“A Spiritual Journey” Reading.** Where to find it? It is in the Living Clean book. Sam will text Kerry M. the information. It’s an optional reading, but if your group wants to read it then go for it, per Tradition Four.
- d. **Schedule PDF of ONLY Houston Area Meetings.** Is it possible to get a Houston Area ONLY (*without Northside and Tri-County Areas*) meeting schedule PDF on the website? It would make it easier to print for our home group members. Per Facilitator, they were playing around with the PDF on the website, but without a current PR Chair or Webservant, we really cannot do anything at the moment.
