## VII. **New Business**

- A. Reginald P reports that there are issues with A&K that are not conducive to the atmosphere of recovery, going against the primary purpose.
1. Group wants HASCONA to come in and facilitate a meeting to restore the atmosphere of recovery.
    - a) Reached out to Region and World, who suggested reaching back more locally.
  2. Ronnie suggests doing a workshop as the facilitator of HASCONA, "as a first line of defense".
    - a) Suggests Brian N and Sarah N to attend that workshop.
      - (1) Brian N wants Scottie and Reginald to reach out via email to detail the specifics of the conflict within the group so that the conflict is not directly addressed, as he believes it will further cause disruption.
      - (2) Sarah N believes that inviting area members would put them in the position of authority and promote 'us vs them'.
    - b) This is because Region should be invited as things don't work on the area level.
    - c) Justin E (Keep It Clean) says that they have had to bar people from the group temporarily, inviting them to return for the business meeting with their sponsor to face up to the natural consequences of their actions and potentially get the bar lifted.
  3. Scottie points out that they were trying to host the disruptive & violent behaviour workshop and that the regional delegate would be willing to chair a necessary informational panel on this subject.
    - a) Sam G, former GSR for Chance for Freedom, was willing to help by providing the facility.
    - b) Ruben, RD, agrees to chair the workshop April 5th.
  4. Sarah N wants to clarify what kind of support the group wants.
    - a) Scottie wants attendance and coordination.
  5. Lauren B wants to know what can and will be done about this, and expresses concern about the newcomer's wellbeing.
  6. Brian N points out that removing the meeting from the list does not promote the atmosphere of recovery.
  7. Robbin states that there are subgroups within the group that are causing friction with one another.
    - a) Looking for a solution for the disruption first and foremost, and everything else will fall in line.
    - b) There is a specific person causing this issue that is making others feel unsafe.
    - c) Robbin stands behind the workshop.
  8. Ryan S suggests delivering the new IP on D&V Behaviour to this group.

9. Sarah N suggests calling the police in this situation.
