- A. **1960 Group** - *Lauren P* - The group is hosting their 40th Anniversary celebration on 8/16. The event will be a dessert potluck, and attendees are encouraged to bring a dessert to share with the fellowship. Nothing else to report.
- B. **Alive & Kicking** - *Scottie J* - The group hosted about 300 members throughout the month of July. They are currently seeking new trusted servants, including a recorder, PR chair, GSRa, and co-facilitator. Their 52nd anniversary has been scheduled with a firm date of October 10th and 11th. The last Sunday of the month sees the group celebrating birthdays, while the last Wednesday of the month sees the group celebrating birthdays with their virtual attendees. The group seeks guidance from the Houston area in order to find a new facility at which to host their group, as there is a situation of some kind at their current facility. The group's conscience is still determining the best course of action in regard to the PR Subcommittee's social media policy proposal.
- C. **Beauty of Recovery** - *Sharon W* - All trusted servants' positions are filled within the group as of their last business meeting. The GSR, Sharon W, requested information on how to send contributions to the ASC as well as how to find HASCONA policy.

The group hosts an average of 10-12 members per meeting, and made a \$30 donation to ASC this week. The group is curious as to how the Spanish-speaking groups in the Houston area will be highlighted on the PDF copy of the schedule.
- J. Keep it Clean - Beatrice** - The group is doing well for the month of July. The group has a new H&I representative. There were five birthdays celebrated by the group in the month of July. The group is requesting support for their meetings on Friday and Saturday nights.
- K. Keep it Real - Mo Z** - The group hosts an average of 13 attendees per meeting. They are requesting support from area members in several ways. One is a query as to whether or not other groups can assist with replenishing IPs for their literature rack, as they do not have the funding to continually replace the pamphlets themselves at this time. They also want to know if the ASC can support the group by promoting their events, for which flyers will be sent in to the events email address so that they may be added to the Houston events calendar.
- L. New Heights - Charlie N** - The group's attendance has literally doubled from where it was this time last year, hosting an average of thirty or more people per meeting. There is an immense outpour of support from members of other groups, and the group is hosting a great number of newcomers as well. That said, the group lacks home group members, making managing the service structure taxing. The group has approved funds for the book drive to put books into the hands of newcomers at the upcoming HACNA and Charlie would like to know where to distribute those funds so that the requisite literature can be purchased.
- M. Our Common Bond - Nikki T** - There is a new meeting at OCB, a Friday night candlelight and SPAD meeting. The meeting has an attendance that ranges between 5 and 15 attendees. The group is hosting their annual River Run from September 5th to the 7th, and registration is set to close soon. For more information on registration (which guarantees you a campsite as well as dinner on Friday and Saturday nights during the campout), please reach out to Nikki T or Mike E.

- N. Rainbow of Hope - Tom Z** - The church at which Rainbow of Hope hosts its meetings has not been sold, contrary to popular belief; it appears that the group will be maintaining use of the facility for the foreseeable future, and will update the ASC if there are any major changes. There was one birthday celebrant for the month of June: Carlton, with 25 years. The group averages 25-30 attendees per meeting. They are looking for a new treasurer, as their previous treasurer has stepped down.
- O. Recovery at Work - Kenneth C** - Nothing much has changed; attendance has been steady, 10-12 members per meeting. The group hosts three meetings per week on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Thursdays.
- P. The Sooner the Better - Joe L** - The group has an average attendance of 15 addicts per meeting. Fridays continue to be the group's most attended meeting. Monday nights @ 7pm are requiring support, as their attendance has been low and slow for some time. Last night's anniversary drag show proceeds are still being calculated; all proceeds from the show are going to ASC, to be given directly to HACNA. The group is seeking a couple new trusted servants, with the outreach and chairperson workshop positions open. The group hosts its monthly business meetings on the second Thursday of each month.
- Q. Sunday Starters - Grace** - The group's weekly Sunday morning meetings are still sparsely attended, although they are getting spurts of attendees. There were 15 people in attendance for the meeting this morning. Newcomers blossoming, with several attaining substantial clean time and getting into service. As noted last month, the group has decided to change their business meeting format to quarterly rather than monthly due to lack of service participation; donations will also be sent quarterly.
