## II. FINANCIAL SUBCOMMITTEE

7<sup>th</sup> Tradition donation are down, so if we continue with the current numbers and spend everything in our budget, we will dip into the prudent reserve by \$1090.00. Keep in mind, we only have two months remaining of the fiscal year, and the budgets will reset at zero in January 2026, but some of the budgets for 2025 will need to be reduced.

- Treasurer/Co-Treasurer reduced their budget from \$100.00 to \$0.00.
- H&I reduced their budget from \$3723.22 to \$1500.00.
- PR reduced their budget from \$7127.63 to \$3885.40.
- Anticipated yearly 7<sup>th</sup> tradition income was reduced from \$9400.00 to \$8000.00, further reducing the anticipated TBRNA and NAWS donation from \$940.00 & \$470.00 to \$800.00 & \$400.00.
- Our estimated yearly closing balance was increased from \$0.00 to \$4425.45.
