III. OPEN FORUM

a. RCMs want to hold a workshop on Disruptive and Predatory Behavior in 2026.

1. This will come out of their budget.
2. Needs date, location.
3. Maybe combined with a speaker; someone experienced with Disruptive and Predatory behavior.
4. Maybe combined with a Prejudice in NA workshop.
 1. Scottie spoke with Ruben F. re: a Racism in NA workshop for the SZF (It's in the CAR). There was a suggestion for an IP on Racism in 1992, but nothing ever came of it until now.
 - a. The group consensus is to wait until we have NA literature to complement such a workshop on Racism/Prejudice.

5. NAWS did a webinar recording in July 2025 on Disruptive/Predatory Behavior.

b. Per Chester G., the Gulf Coast Club Board of Directors is now dominated by NA members, and they would be very welcoming and accommodating to hosting Area Activities.

c. **Suggestion to meet in -person quarterly, rather than once/year.** Discussion ensued:

1. Virtual service meetings are less stressful for some members and easier to present reports in.
2. It cost \$150 to meet in person this year vs. less than \$18.00/month for the Zoom account.
3. There's more unified discussion in-person, and more participation by members.
4. Meeting twice or three times/year might be less of an upheaval than four times/year.
5. **STRAW POLL RESULTS:** once/year: 11 votes vs. four times/year: 8 votes.
6. **Any group wanting to change the number of times per year we meet in person can bring a proposal to the next Area meeting.**

d. Religion (encouraging AND disparaging comments) is being brought up in a meeting. They are looking for suggestions to combat this type of sharing.

1. This is a group issue, and the ASC cannot tell the groups how to handle it, but . . .
 1. Maybe speak to the individual(s) making the comments one-on-one outside of the meeting and address this issue. Be respectful of their own spiritual path, but emphasize that *their behavior is creating disunity, which harms everyone*.
 2. Maybe change the group format to include verbiage not to endorse nor degrade any specific religion or spiritual path.
 3. “There is nothing, absolutely nothing, in the NA program that requires a member to be religious. The idea that ‘anyone may join us, regardless of . . . religion or lack of religion’ is fiercely defended by our fellowship. Our members strive to be inclusive in this regard and do not tolerate anything that compromises the unconditional right of all addicts to develop their own individual understanding of a Power greater than themselves. This is a spiritual, not religious, program.” -*The Narcotics Anonymous Step Working Guides, page 11.*


