Facilitator: Anthony W. stated that there were a few things that we need to discuss today concerning the Facilities that we are serving, the coordinator, panel leaders and panel members' role and responsibilities, and the positions that are opened. Anthony previously posted the HASCONA H & I Subcommittee policy and an insert from the H & I handbook in the GROUPME app due to concerns about and chats about sending female members in all male facilities, panel leader/panel members contacting the facilities, and making decisions on the number of panel members on one panel. All concerns need to be brought to his attention and/or at the H & I subcommittee meeting every 3rd Wednesday of the month at 2:30 pm. If there is not a coordinator over a facility, then the responsibilities of that facility fall on him as the facilitator. He discussed that June is elections at the ASC and all positions are open including the Facilitator position for H & I Subcommittee. He reported that he would be qualifying himself for the position as he took it as Interim. He reported that he will be moving to Galveston and that he

has spoken to several members and as long as he maintains a homegroup in the Area then he can remain here.

Literature: Monya reported that a literature order and current in stock has been sent to Anthony W. Anthony shared the screen and the worksheet for May was shown which included the current in stock quantities and the current reorder for the literature. The literature worksheet is attached. Reported that our proposal to ASC for \$5141.75 was approved, please see the attached proposal. Included in that proposal was a 20-pocket literature rack requested by Julie P, facilities coordinator for Virtue Recovery, and will be ordered with our literature order. The literature rack that is currently at Virtue Recovery will be given back and held for future use at another facility. There were no questions.

Public Relations: Brian N. reported that PR is present and how PR subcommittee is directly related to H & I subcommittee. Please refer to his minutes at the ASC posted on the HASONA website.

Facilities/Coordinators Reports

Chyenye Center: Coordinator position remains open for this facility as Brian N. has been filling in to make sure the meeting is happening every week, which it is and has had several panel members show up. Literature is good right now. Al R. is the panel leader for the 3rd week, and Kevin R. is the panel leader for the 4th week. Al R. reported that it is his job to vet the members that he takes into facilities on his week and his job to determine if they are ready or not to remain on a panel as a member or move onto a panel leader position. He feels that it is not ok to suggest that they go to another week until he thinks they are prepared. He apologized for overstepping and going to the facility without following policy. He is announcing at every meeting that he goes to in order to get more panel members. Brian N stated that he is grateful for the many members that are showing up now. Evony M. stated that it's good to get many people. Sam stated that A & K is willing to take a meeting in, and Anthony stated that they would get together after the meeting. Anthony stated that everyone's goal is the same: to get all meetings every week covered.

Santa Maria Hostel: Yami is present and has carried out this meeting for a very long time and has brought another member with her who she would like to nominate to step up for the coordinator position. Anthony stated that he needed to know who the volunteer coordinator is and a phone number to reach them. Yami did not know who the current one is but will get the information. Monya stated that she looked on the website and it looks like maybe Fernando Perez? She will get Anthony the information. Otherwise, all is good with the meeting. The meeting is held every Friday at 6 pm. It's a women's only facility and there is no application to prequalify. Just go with the coordinator. She reported that Santa Maria would like to add a meeting for the women in the WHOA TDCJ program. Anthony stated that at this time we will put that on hold.

Women's Home: Cathryn P is absent. Monya reported that the literature is good there. We have had great participation with the client's showing up. There are no problems with

the facility at this time all meetings were covered for this month. There still has not been a meeting amongst the members going into the facility due to scheduling conflicts. Cathryn had posted in the GROUPME app for Women's home that she would not be coming to this meeting, and I suggested that she contact Anthony, which she said she would. Not sure why this did not happen.

Virtue Recovery: Julie P. is present and states that the meetings are going well. She reported that there are at least 2 or more panel members every Friday with 10-15 or more clients showing up for the meeting. Julie stated excitement over getting the new literature rack so that she could stock all the IP'S. The requirements were emailed to her during the meeting and Anthony asked her if she had time to read them and she did. He went over the requirements, and the CC qualified herself with clean date of 8/2/22 and she has been involved in serving as a panel member and panel leader at the facility. She is willing and able to take on this 1-year commitment. There were no abstentions and she is now the Facility Coordinator for Santa Maria Hostel. Congratulations CC. and thank you so much to Yami for her continued service at this facility.

Al R. brought up that we should not take on new meetings.
